PE Days

EYFS (Reception / Nursery): Tuesday (please wear usual uniform to school and bring a PE kit to get changed in to)

Please ensure that you read the letter which goes alongside these books and gives you more information about reading at New Park Primary Academy. If you have any questions, please speak to your children's class teacher.

Phonics linked books for Reception children will be sent out before the October half-term.

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Positive Behaviour

If you have heard your children talking about Bee's recently, this may be due to our New Park Principles - The 3 Bee's - 'Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Ready to Learn'.
