


<p>Spend at least 15 minutes a day practising your times tables https://trockstars.com/ https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button https://www.timestables.co.uk/</p>	<p>Spend at least 15 minutes a day practising your spellings / phonics (see spelling list overleaf) https://play.edshed.com/login https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/</p>	<p>Design a WW2 poster to encourage people to ration / grow their own food / make do and mend. Remember, keep it colourful and catchy!</p>
<p><u>S.M.I.R.Fs:</u></p> <p>Practice your current planet for 15 minutes a day. Find all planets on our school website. http://www.newparkacademy.co.uk/our-school/curriculum/</p>	<p>Write your own non – chronological report about a different animal. It could be a pet, an animal from one of your books at home, or your favourite animal. Remember – a non-chronological report is completely factual and uses subheadings which can be written in any order.</p>	<p>Write a comparison of how life is different now, for children, compared to in the war. You could focus on toys, school, games etc.</p>
<p>Y2 - Column Addition and Subtraction – 2 digit by 2 digit: Practise the column method with your tens and ones, then have a go at drawing them out and then practising with just the numbers. Why don't you use a dice/number cards to generate your numbers and make some column subtraction and addition questions of your own! Remember the rules for regrouping and exchanging.</p> <p>Y1 – Add and subtract up to 20 using objects found at home. Practice reading and writing numbers up to 100</p>	<p>Write your own ending to the novel "The Whale's Song." Does Lilly find the Whales? Do they sing to her? What does Uncle Frederick do? Does Lilly's flower gift work?</p> <p>Remember to use amazing adjectives, super similes and cracking conjunctions!</p>	<p>Bake some bread.</p> <p>Can you make a loaf of bread using a different flavour? You could then write instructions to give to your friends when you get back to school.</p>
<p><u>Multiplication – 1 x 1 digit</u> Why don't you use a dice/number cards to generate a number up to 12 and multiply it by either 2, 5 or 10! Remember use your arrays!</p> 	<p>Re-write 'The Whales' Song' from Uncle Frederick's perspective. Remember to write in the first person – You are the cantankerous Uncle Frederick!</p>	<p>The war is over! To celebrate people up and down the country held VE parties. Design your own VE day celebration – Can you create a colourful food menu and some unique party games.</p>
<p><u>Division – Grouping and sharing</u></p> <p>Pick a number from the 2, 5 or 10 times table and divide it by either 2, 5 or 10! Remember use your groups.</p> 	<p>Write a book review for any and all books you read. Did you like it/not like it? Why? What were the characters like? What was your favourite part? Redesign a new book cover and blurb for it.</p>	<p>Research and play outdoor games which would have been played by children in the 1940s.</p> <p>Design and test a parachute (using a toy) that would allow a member of the RAF to land safely.</p>
