Dear Parent/Carer,

We are excited to finally be able to offer our Year 5/6 children a residential visit to Marrick Priory in Richmond. This has been provisionally booked for **Wednesday 9th February to Friday 11th February 2022**. At New Park we take the children away on a residential every two years, so they have the chance to go once, either in Year 5 or Year 6.

The cost of this trip is £160 per child. This includes travel between the school and Marrick Priory, accommodation, all food and a full programme of activities.

We have been very conscious of keeping the cost of this trip as low as possible and have reduced the length of our stay from a whole week to three days. This visit represents good value for money given the quality of instruction and care provided.

Additionally, there are some pupils for whom we receive additional funding, known as Pupil Premium, some of which we can use to further reduce costs. If your child is eligible for free school meals, the cost of the residential is £75.

There are four key dates for payments to be made by:
