Dear Parents and Children,

Welcome back to the start of the Summer term.

First of all we start with some good news regarding the school building. Our application for funding to replace the flat-roofed extensions at either end of the upper building and above the room used for out of hours club in the lower building has been approved. Work is scheduled to take place during the Summer. Once this is completed we will look at the internal refurbishment of the main reception and toilet area, cloakroom and toilets in the upper and lower buildings.
