| <p><b>Column Addition and Subtraction – 4 digit by 4 digit:</b><br/>Practise the column method with your hundreds, tens and ones, then have a go at drawing them out and then practising with just the numbers.<br/>Why don't you use a dice/number cards to generate your numbers and make some column subtraction and addition questions of your own!<br/>Remember the rules for regrouping and exchanging</p> | <p>Imagine Lucy talks to one of the wolves in the house.<br/>Write a persuasive speech as Lucy to the wolves persuading them to leave the house</p>   | <p>You are chosen to go on a mission to Mars. You are only allowed to pack 10 items.<br/>What items will you pack and why?<br/>Either write or draw them.</p>                          |
| <p><b>Column Multiplication – 3 digit x 1 digit</b><br/>Why don't you use a dice/number cards to generate your numbers and make some column multiplication questions of your own!<br/>Remember the rules for regrouping and if you're stuck use your arrays</p>  | <p>Come up with an alliterative sentence for everyone you know. The sillier the better!<br/>E.g. Miss Watson wonderfully walked whilst whistling.</p>   | <p>Keep a sky at night journal in the back of your book. Write everything you can see in the sky. You could draw a picture of the moon every night!<br/>Do you notice any changes?</p> |
| <p><b>Division (bus stop method) – 3 digit ÷ 1 digit</b><br/>Why don't you use a dice/number cards to generate your numbers and make some division questions of your own!<br/>Remember the rules for exchanging and if you're stuck use your arrays</p>  | <p>Write a book review for any and all books you read.<br/>Did you like it/not like it? Why? What were the characters like?<br/>What was your favourite part?<br/>Redesign a new book cover and blurb for it.</p> | <p>Keep a record of at least one good thing that happens every day. No matter how big or small.<br/>You can write it/draw it.<br/>Keep them all safe in a good times jar/pot.</p>      |
