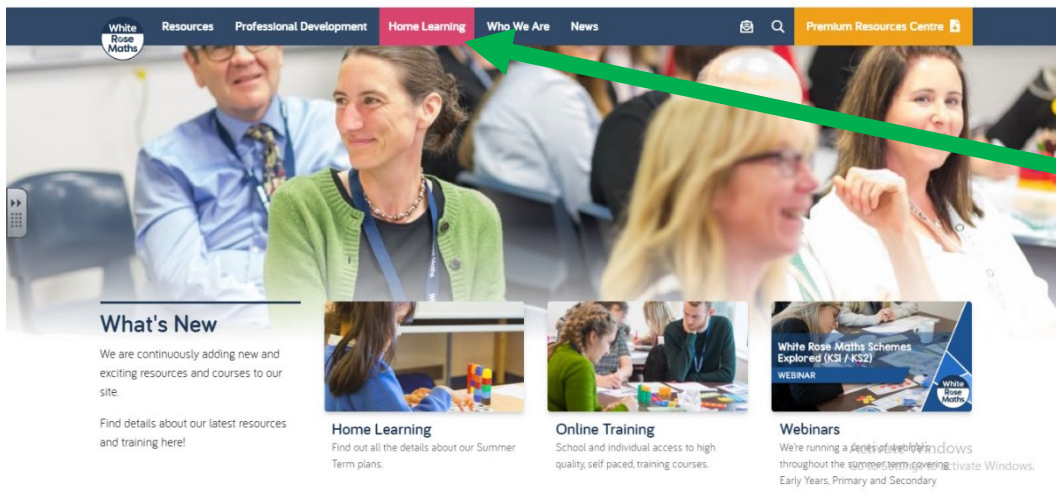


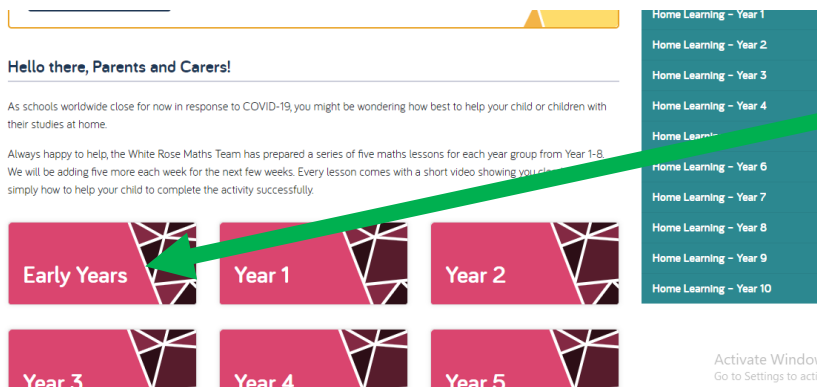
Nursery Maths Home Learning
