Dear parents & carers,

Coronavirus

We continue to support test and trace service during half term. Please inform us via email if your child tests positive for Coronavirus over the break. Unfortunately, we were forced to close half the school at the end of April due to positive cases across EYFS and KS1. This was a reminder to all of us that the threat of COVID has not completely subsided. Please do not send your child to school if anyone in your household has symptoms until you have received a negative PCR test result. The lateral flow self-test devices are not suitable when a child has symptoms.



Support for families

The last year has seen community groups and charities come together to support families who have been hit hardest by the pandemic. I am really proud of the support we have been able to provide as a school and trust - we are working with local charities to again provide food vouchers and parcels over the half-term break. As always, please contact the office if you are facing food shortages or financial difficulties as we work closely with agencies and charities across Harrogate and can signpost you to services that can offer help and support.

Over the last two years we have been investing in ICT provision across the school. Last year we updated all KS1 and KS2 classrooms with new projectors and visualisers. This year we have purchased touchscreen laptops for our classrooms so that the children have continuous access to technology as and when they need it. This is particularly beneficial for regular practise of spellings and maths knowledge. This week we were thrilled to install two huge touchscreens in Nursery and Reception, giving our children a brilliant new resource for teaching and playing educational games – have a look on our Facebook page to see how they got on!
